Spokespersons' Committee

Reminder of important elements from the January 31st 2024 committee:

- * The partners of the RDSBM were invited on February 27th to come and share their comments, incomprehensions or appreciations on the governance structure of the RDSBM, in order to improve it collectively;
- The final budget of the transversal concerns was presented (on page
 2);
- * The RDSBM submitted a new request to the FLAC in January in regards to the transversal concerns in the territory and the demands requested by the tables;
- The residual money of \$30,989 from the transversal concerns was allocated to food security during the assembly of the RDSBM last November. The sum was divided as follows by the participants at the poverty and food security table on January 25th:

Cowansville CAB and Pleins Rayons project will receive \$20,000, the Farnham CAB's project will receive \$4,000, the Centre Marguerite Dubois project in Bromont will receive \$4,000 and the remaining amount (\$2,989) will be distributed between the remaining organizations (Sutton CAB, Ville de Lac- Brome and Centre La-le-li);

- In terms of outreach work, the 3 organizations (Bromont, Lac-Brome and Farnham) which had requested funding for ITMAV were refused;
- The first citizen consultation on the MRC's strategic planning will take place in a few weeks on the Cocoriko consultation platform, This consultation aims to survey the citizens' opinions on the future of Brome-Missisquoi and to create an action plan on a regional scale that will develop the territory with organizations, businesses, cities, etc.;
- Food security and social health inequalities will be presented to the next health committee.
